Shall the City of Owosso, Shiawassee County, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor in one or more series, payable in not to exceed twenty-five (25) years from the date of issue of each series, for the purpose of paying the city's costs of acquiring and constructing local and major street improvements in the city consisting of paving, repaving, reconstructing and improving streets, sidewalks, parking areas, and trails, and all necessary appurtenances and attachments thereto? The estimated millage to be levied in 2015 is 2.1959 mills (per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds is 2.4451 mills (per \$1,000 of taxable value).

BALLOT PROPOSAL

Shall Chapter 7, Section 7.4 of the DURAND CITY CHARTER be amended to read as follows:

Section 7.4. Each ordinance shall be published within 15 days after its enactment in one of the following four methods: (a) The full text thereof may be published in a newspaper as defined in Section 17.9 or (b) in cases of ordinances over five hundred words in length a digest, summary or statement of purpose of the ordinance, approved by the Council may be published in a newspaper as defined in Section 17.9 or (c) in cases where an ordinance adopts a state, national or international code a statement of the adoption of said code along with a statement where the code can be reviewed by an interested person may be published in a newspaper as defined in Section 17.9 or (d) any ordinance shall be deemed published if it is posted on the official website of the City of Durand in a prominent manner and designed to be easily retrieved and read.

The remaining two paragraphs of Section 7.4 shall remain unchanged.

BALLOT PROPOSAL

Shall Chapter 12, Section 12.1 of the DURAND CITY CHARTER be amended by changing the second and third paragraphs thereof to read as follows:

Comparative prices shall be obtained for the purchase or sale not in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) of all materials, supplies and public improvements except in the employment of professional services, with the amount stated herein to be amended annually commencing in 2014 at the rate of inflation as determined by the Consumer Price Index.

In all sales or purchases in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) or as the amount is amended annually pursuant to the preceding paragraph, (a) the sale or purchase shall be approved by the Council (b) sealed bids shall be obtained, and (c) the requirements of Section 12.2 shall be complied with. No sale or purchase shall be divided for the purpose of circumventing the dollar value limitation contained in this section. The Council may authorize the making of public improvements or the performance of any other city work by any city agency without competitive bidding.

BALLOT PROPOSAL

Shall the authorized millage for the City of Durand, established at 20 mills (\$20.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and reduced to 16.5304 mills (\$16.5304 per \$1,000 of taxable value), by the required millage rollbacks, be increased in an amount not to exceed 3.4696 mills (\$3.4696 per \$1,000 of taxable value) to restore the full amount of the original authorized charter rate for each year for three years, 2013 to 2016, inclusive, for all City and municipal purposes authorized by law; and shall the City levy such new additional millage?

The estimate of the revenue the City will collect if the millage is authorized and levied by the City in the 2013 calendar year is approximately \$207,090, a portion of which (\$9,673) will be disbursed to the Durand Downtown Development Authority.

BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Byron Area Schools, Shiawassee, Livingston and Genesee Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Five Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$5,350,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

partially remodeling, furnishing and refurbishing, equipping and re-equipping school facilities; acquiring, installing and equipping educational technology for school facilities; resurfacing and re-equipping the existing running track; purchasing school buses; and developing and improving sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2014, under current law, is 1.87 mills (\$1.87 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-five (25) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 1.84 mills (\$1.84 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$-0-. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$-0-. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to levy 14.7771 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2013 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 14.7771 mills (\$14.7771 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Perry Public Schools, Shiawassee and Ingham Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2014 to 2023, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2014 is approximately \$634,600 (this is a renewal of millage which will expire with the 2013 tax levy)?

OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Perry Public Schools, Shiawassee and Ingham Counties, Michigan, be increased by 3.2229 mills (\$3.2229 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2014 to 2023, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2014 is approximately \$138,500 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?
