Statement: The Local State of Emergency in Shiawassee County has expired.

The local State of Emergency that was declared on 22 December 2013 at 0528 / 5:28am for Shiawassee County expired on 29 December 2013 at 0528 / 5:28am. With the warm temperatures and melting of ice that occurred this weekend icy conditions were made more manageable County roads, to include previously impassable secondary and dirt roads, have been determined to be open for travel. Some areas may still experience debris or even power lines along the shoulders of roadways, so remain cautious as you travel. Any residence who may remain without power can still seek refuge in warming centers. Emergency Management is encouraging residence to call 2-1-1 for more information about assistance available in Shiawassee County.
