Purpose: State of Emergency Lifted

Statement: The Local State of Emergency in Shiawassee County has been lifted.

The local State of Emergency that was declared on 05 January 2014 at 1943:28 / 7:34:28 pm for Shiawassee County expired on 09 January 2014 at 0800 / 8:00 am. A Local State of Emergency was declared for Shiawassee County due to heavy snow fall amounts with blowing and drifting snow, causing roadways to become hazardous and impassible.

To avoid accidents and to aid public safety response, all residents were notified to stay off of the roads. Efforts to clear snow for travel have been successful and as of 0800 / 8:00 am 9 January 2014 the Chairman of the Shiawassee County Board of Commissioners lifted the Local State of Emergency Declaration.
