

**Shiawassee County Friend of the Court**  
**SUPERVISED PARENTING TIME POLICY**

These rules are necessary to provide a stable, positive experience for your child(ren). Lack of cooperation with the rules may result in termination of services.

1. Visitation shall not commence until the parties supply the Supervisor with a signed copy of their court Order.
2. All physical interaction and communication between parent and child will be monitored. Parent and child will not be left unattended at any time.
3. Custodial parent is responsible for dropping off and picking up child. If custodial parent is not available, another responsible adult must bring the child to the parenting time. Custodial parent shall immediately pay \$1.00 per minute for each minute they are late directly to the PT Supervisor.
4. Parenting time must be arranged in advance. Parent and child may not leave the location at any time without prior approval of the supervisor.
5. Twenty-four-hour notice is required to cancel and/or reschedule a visit.
6. Neither parent will discuss the other parent nor the terms of the parenting time in the presence of the child or with the supervisor during the visit. Concerns may be addressed by making an appointment to meet the supervisor at a separate time.
7. Confrontations or arguments between parents at any time during the parenting time WILL NOT be permitted.
8. No other visitors are allowed during the parenting time without prior authorization from the supervisor. The supervisor will make the final decision whether or not additional persons will be allowed at the visit.
9. DRUG or ALCOHOL use will result in denial of parenting time.
10. No smoking allowed during parenting time.
11. The Supervisor and visiting parent will determine the location of the parenting time unless otherwise indicated in the court order. Custodial parent **does not** determine parenting time location.
12. The custodial parent will leave the premises during the parenting time, unless otherwise indicated in the court order or arranged by Friend of the Court.
13. Timing of the parents' arrival for parenting time shall be arranged so that the parents will have no contact. For example, the custodial parent may be asked to arrive with the child five to ten minutes early, leave the premises, and then the visiting parent arrives. The opposite would happen at the end of the visit.
14. Payments for parenting time must be made prior to the start of each visit.
15. Firearms, or weapons of any kind, are strictly prohibited during supervised parenting time visits.

**THREATS, ACTS OF VIOLENCE, LACK OF COOPERATION WITH THE OBSERVER OR BREAKING OF ANY OF THE RULES MAY RESULT IN IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF SUPERVISED PARENTING TIME, AND MAY RESULT IN LEGAL ACTION.**
