Bath Community Schools

BOND PROPOSAL

Shall Bath Community Schools, Clinton and Shiawassee Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Fourteen Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$14,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to school buildings; remodeling, installing security measures for, furnishing and refurbishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; acquiring and installing instructional technology and instructional technology equipment for school buildings; purchasing school buses; remodeling and improving athletic facilities; and developing and improving parking areas and sites?

Chesaning Union Schools

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Chesaning Union Schools, Saginaw and Shiawassee Counties, Michigan, be increased by 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2017 to 2022, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2017 is approximately \$918,765 (this is a renewal of millage that expired with the 2016 tax levy)?

Haslett Public Schools

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2017 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 21.4477 mills (\$21.4477 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Haslett Public Schools, Ingham, Clinton and Shiawassee Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 20 years, 2018 to 2037, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2018 is approximately \$2,000,000 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2017 tax levy and will not be levied in excess of the statutorily authorized levy limitation)?

SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Laingsburg Community Schools, Shiawassee and Clinton Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 4 years, 2017 to 2020, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2017 is approximately \$194,000?

MILLAGE PROPOSAL SINKING FUND TAX LEVY

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Perry Public Schools, Shiawassee and Ingham Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed .8 mill (\$.80 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2017 to 2021, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology, and for all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2017 is approximately \$198,000?
