

PARK RULES *Please give us your cooperation*

1. PUBLIC USE AND HOURS: Parks are open at 8 a.m. and closed at sunset.
2. Person reserving park pavilion is responsible for leaving the area clean and disposing of trash in the proper receptacles. Failure to do so may result in a fine.
3. It is unlawful to remove, cut, deface or destroy any vegetation, whether alive or dead.
4. No fires allowed except in the fireplaces and grills provided.
5. No person shall hunt or attempt to hunt, trap, catch, wound or kill any bird or other animals upon any land or water owned by the County.
6. No motor-driven vehicle of any kind or nature shall operate on any park grounds, except on park roads or designated areas.
7. No person shall act in a manner that disturbs the peace, quiet, or tranquility of the area, such as loud radios, loud music, or operate motor-driven vehicles which results in excessive noise or disturbs the peace, quiet, or tranquility of the area.
8. No person shall fire, discharge, or have in his or her possession any fireworks or any substance of an explosive nature within or upon County property.
9. No firearms are allowed on County property. No firearms shall be discharged within, upon, or onto County property.
10. It is unlawful to litter County property or discharge any solid or liquid in water within the boundaries of the park which may or shall result in the pollution of the water.
11. No person shall act in a manner that causes a public disturbance.
12. Vandalism is unlawful and shall be prosecuted to triple the amount of damages.
13. No person shall sell, use or have in their possession any alcoholic beverage drug or narcotic.
14. Violations of these rules shall be prosecuted under provisions of the County park's ordinance or applicable state laws.
